2019 Highlights

- ◆ October 1st saw the introduction of the ROAM bus (Rural Older Adults in Motion) which provides free or reduced-cost travel to area seniors covering a nearly 200 square mile area. This program is made possible by a grant from the Glacier Hills Legacy Fund and managed by the Ann Arbor Area Community Foundation.
- ◆ Our variety of activities & programs expanded even further to over 250 per month! 2019 saw the introduction of new programs such as Chelsea Coffeehouse (memory care support), Drums-Alive cardio-drumming, a Genealogy Help Group, and Trivia Fridays. All told, members spent a total of nearly 100,000 hours here at CSC.
- ◆ Our amazing and committed team of senior volunteers logged over 12,000 hours helping others with Meals on Wheels deliveries & meal prep, sewing, tech support, friendly calls, health screenings, office support, and of course travel trips. The CAADY Quilters donated 106 quilts to U of M patients.
- ◆ 2019 was a year of transition as we saw the retirement of Trinh Pifer and the hiring of Bill O'Reilly as Executive Director. And rightfully so, Trinh was awarded the Chelsea Citizen of the Year Award.
- ◆ As planned, the Grass Lake Senior Center became a completely separate operation on December 31, 2019.

Annual Report 2019

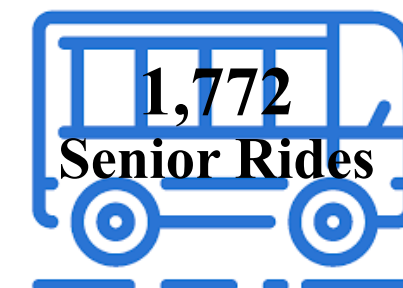

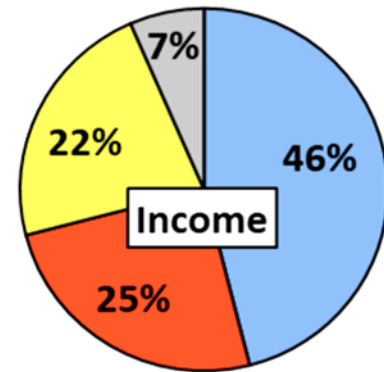

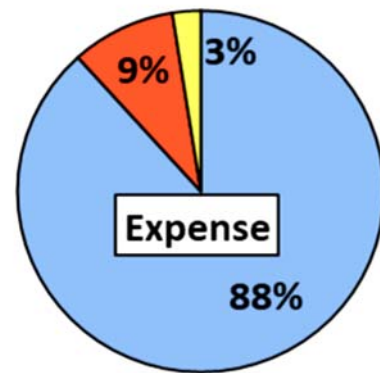
