2022 Highlights

- A very full year of activities getting to our new normal. Nearly all of our programs returned and we introduced new ones—over 250 activities per month! These programs are possible in large part due to the ongoing support of our donors.
- The return of key events and an updated look for Chelsea Expo & Gifts of Autumn.
- Introduction of Memory Care programs to help both those dealing with early stage memory issues and their loved ones. Funding provided by 5 Healthy Towns.
- The awarding of grant funds to start up our Ease the Day our program to provide Caregivers with needed downtime. Funding provided by the Exhale program of the Ralph C. Wilson Foundation. This will be rolled out in the first quarter of 2023.
- Starting up the GrandPads program to encourage area seniors to try these simple to use tablets for connecting to loved ones and staying engaged. Funding for this program provided by the Chelsea Community Foundation.
- Our Travel program returned to full force with a wide variety of trips including 44 CSC members traveling to Scotland for nearly 2 weeks.


